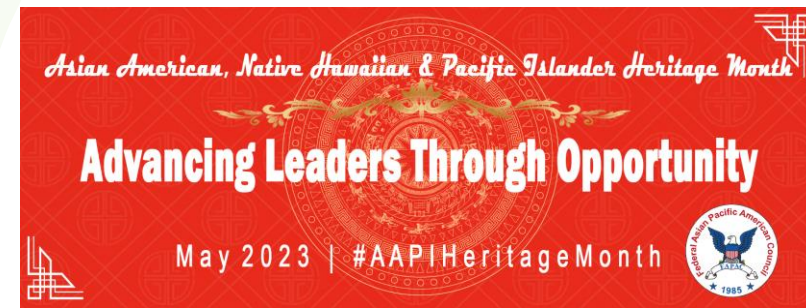

# Hub and Spoke Integration

# Facilitators and Barriers Vermont Hub and Spoke (Brooklyn and Sigmon, 2017)

- Relationships, Relationships, Relationships
- Assessment of patients' treatment needs to determine appropriate level of care
- Hub Medical Directors took on role of mentors and went into the communities - champions
- Staff shortages, particularly among nurses and clinicians
- Difficulty ensuring accurate data collection across a network of treatment sites
- Few buprenorphine prescribers and low prescribing by buprenorphine prescribers

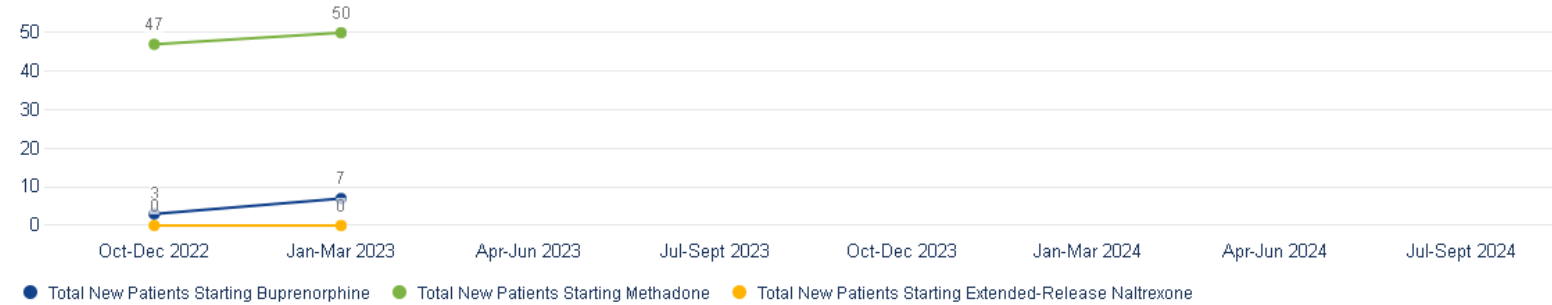

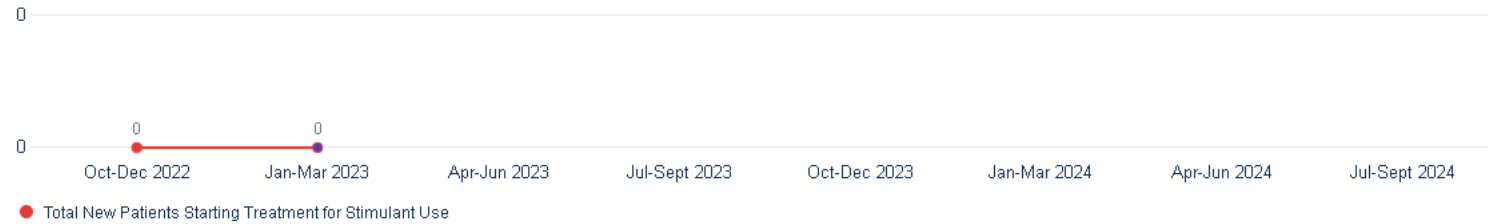




# New Patients Starting Treatment for Stimulants

Total New Patients Starting Any Treatment for Stimulant Use per Quarter

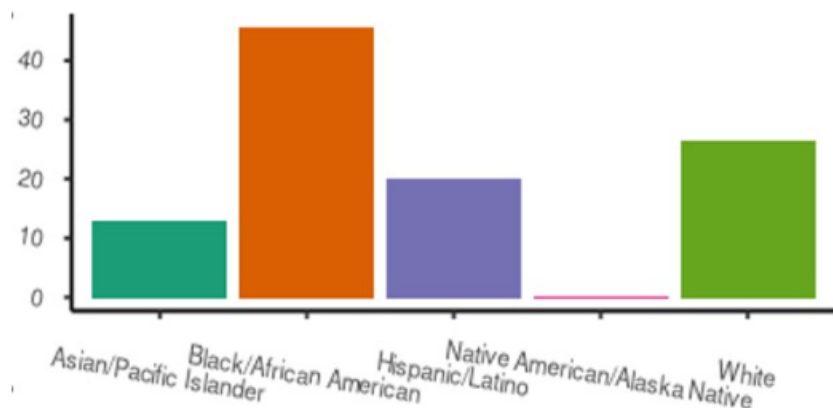


# Overdose by Race/Ethnicity

Any Opioid-Related Overdose Deaths by Race/Ethnicity , 2021  
Crude Rate per 100,000 Residents



In 2021, there were **17 opioid-related** and **16 psychostimulant-related** overdose deaths.

### Deaths by Race/Ethnicity

- **Opioids:** 64.7% of deaths were among residents who were white alone. Data for other racial/ethnic categories are suppressed. However, this means that **35.3% of deaths were among people of color.**
- **Psychostimulants:** 50% of deaths were among residents who were white alone, and 37.5% were among Hispanic/Latinx residents. Data for other racial/ethnic categories are suppressed. However, this means that **50% of deaths were among people of color.**

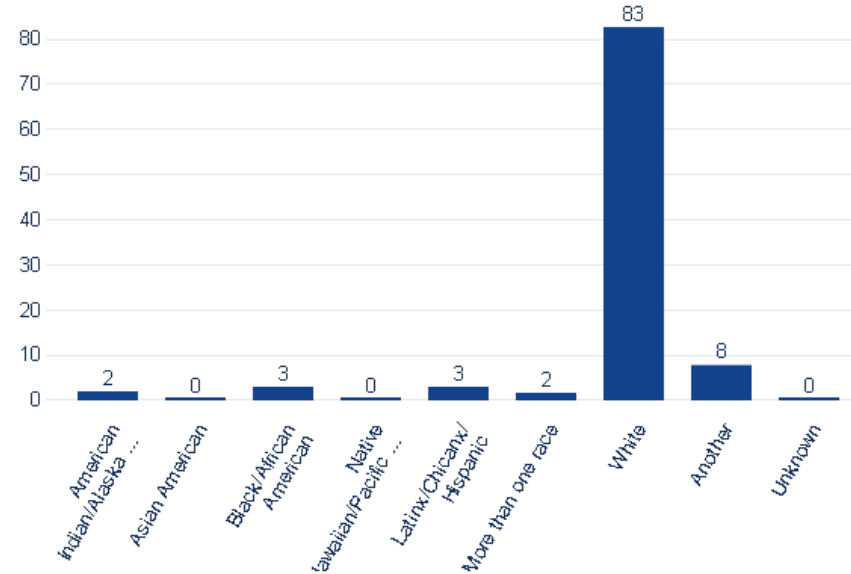

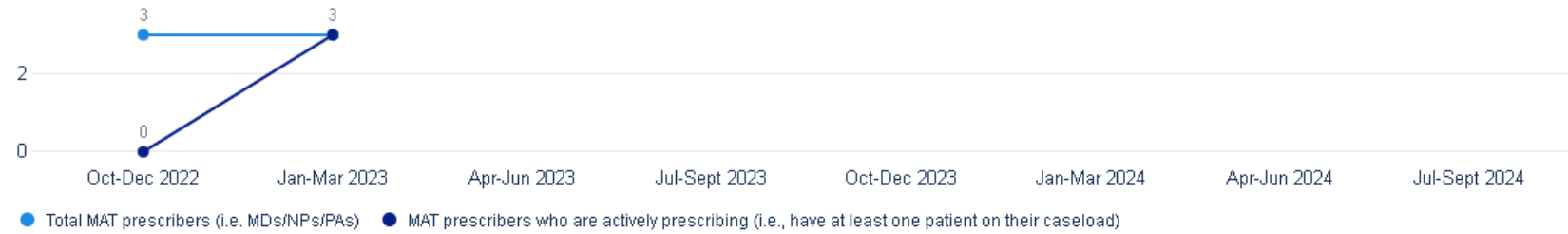

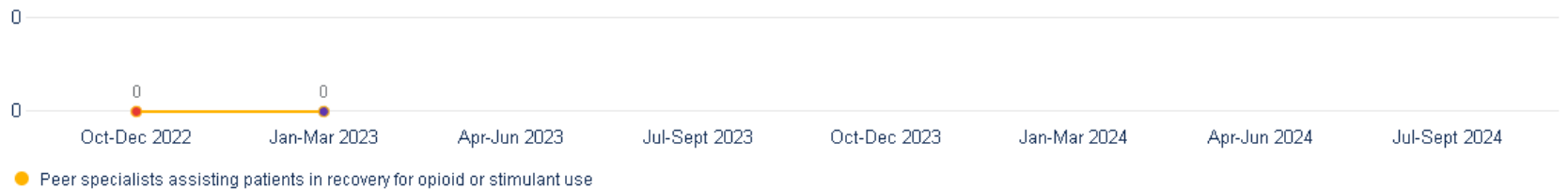
# Number of Providers

Total Peer Specialists by Quarter

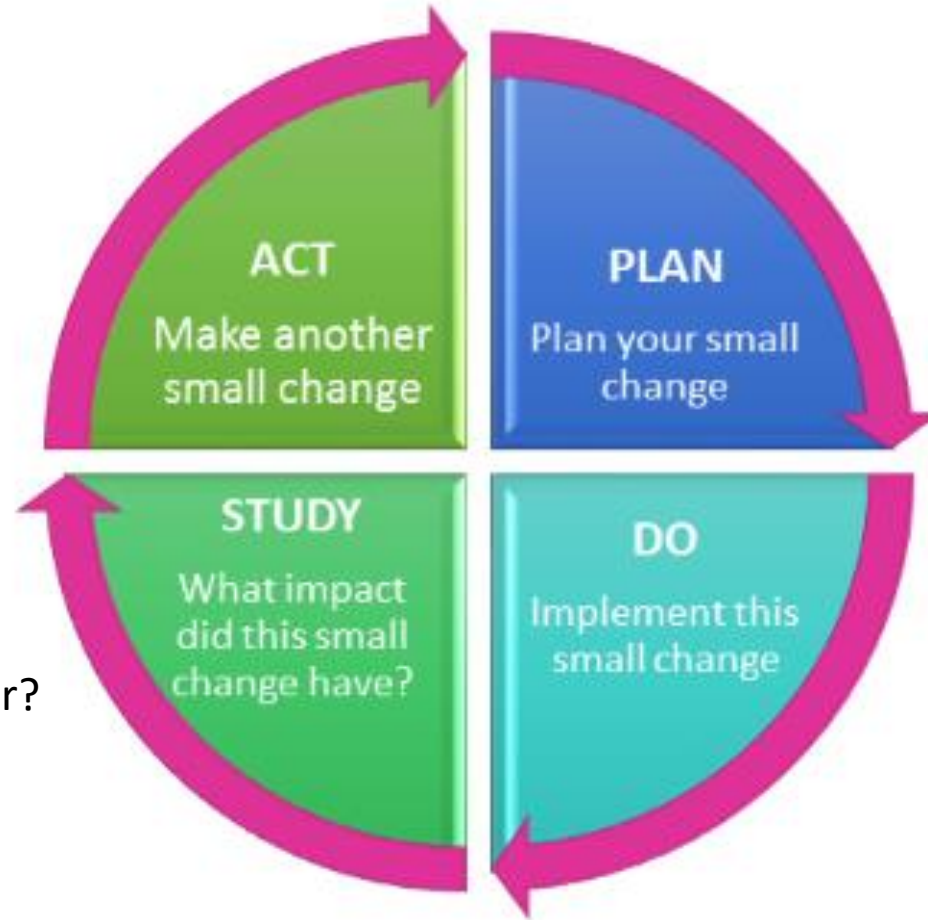
