- FHCSD- Good in environmental support, ok on funding stability currently, great partnerships with Bridge program and other community agencies, MAT sites continue to develop
 - Overall program evaluation- continue to assess reports/data and make changes as needed
 - Program adaptations- leadership continues to do that "what can we add to program"
 - Trainings and resources are available anytime to all staff
 - Only question is future sustainability for MAT program -but have made sure certain things won't end if funding ends
- St. John's- look at organization as a whole, not as a separate MAT program
 - Staff relies upon grants = stress inducing with the unknown

Choose one area where you plan to take action for the sustainability of your program.

- FHCSD-
 - If staff is available, have a weekly MAT group
 - SUD counselors (and others)- since they are not billable
- St. John's-
 - No personal/private offices for patients and staff to meet
 - Hiring staff that can work with non-english patients
 - Sustainability for SUD counselors and other staff that are grant funded

- No good solution for SUD counselor sustainability
 - Lobbying
- Make sure there is funding from multiple sources rather than just one
- Extend the grants for longer than 2 years (reduce turnover)
- Have a competitive wage for the counselors

What are your key takeaways from your review of the PSAT?

- Part of a larger sustained organization
- Partnerships Community outreach
- Challenges with patients who receive Grant Funding (Funding stability)

Breakout Room 6:

What are your key takeaways from your review of the PSAT?

- Father Joe's Village inception in 2018 MAT Program; Retention seems to be a major area of concern. Folks can be inducted and initiated into the treatment, but there is high drop-out rates. Can relate to Organizational Capacity and managing patients to complete program goals.
- JWCH- Funding Stability is a major area of concern due to the entire grant-funding nature of the addiction treatment. How to find a more sustainable stream of funding.
- Program Evaluation and making sure to align metrics and outcomes to ensure funding sustainment across different sources; and
 figuring out how to address some duplicative grant reporting/evaluation tools that may already be collected from existing surveillance
 and questionnaires from the health system.

Choose one area where you plan to take action for the sustainability of your program.

Organizational Capacity

- JWCH Figuring out how to integrate substance use treatment into existing program rather than other burdensome state funded programs that may require excess administrative burden on evaluation and data collection and management (and documentation that goes beyond existing protocols and processes).
- Father Joe's' also figuring out how to integrate and sustain program without incorporating too many new state or federal funding sources that may limit flexibility of services and alignment with mission and values as an organization.

What are your key takeaways from your review of the PSAT?

- Incorp intaking treatment, MAT, MAT enrollment
- Org capacity, staff vs patients etc, burn out ratio. Trying to find a healthy balance
- Advocating for increase number of staffing
